Kids entering preschool through grade 5 who read or are read to for **at least** 12 hours during the program will receive a ribbon and *free admission* into the 2008 Stratham Fair.



Dates: June 22-July 17

Goal: 12 hours of independent or family reading

Prize: Free Admission to the Fair

Instructions:

Keep track of what you're reading (titles & authors) and the amount of time you spend reading on the Ferris Wheel picture.

1. For each hour read, color in 1/2 (top or bottom) of 1 ferris wheel basket.
2. It doesn't matter how many things you read — as long as it adds up to 12 hours total.
3. When all 6 baskets are colored in, go to the Library, turn in your Ferris Wheel and collect your ribbon! *The completed reading chart must be turned in by **July 16th** to receive a ribbon & free admission. One ribbon & admission per person.*

Reading for 12 hours? It's Easy!

If you read 30 minutes per day during the program you will have read *more than* 12 hours by July 20!

As you read, keep track of the time next to the titles. For example:

Where the Wild Things Are by M. Sendak (15 min.)

Geronimo Stilton, by Stilton (30 min., 30 min. 30 min.)

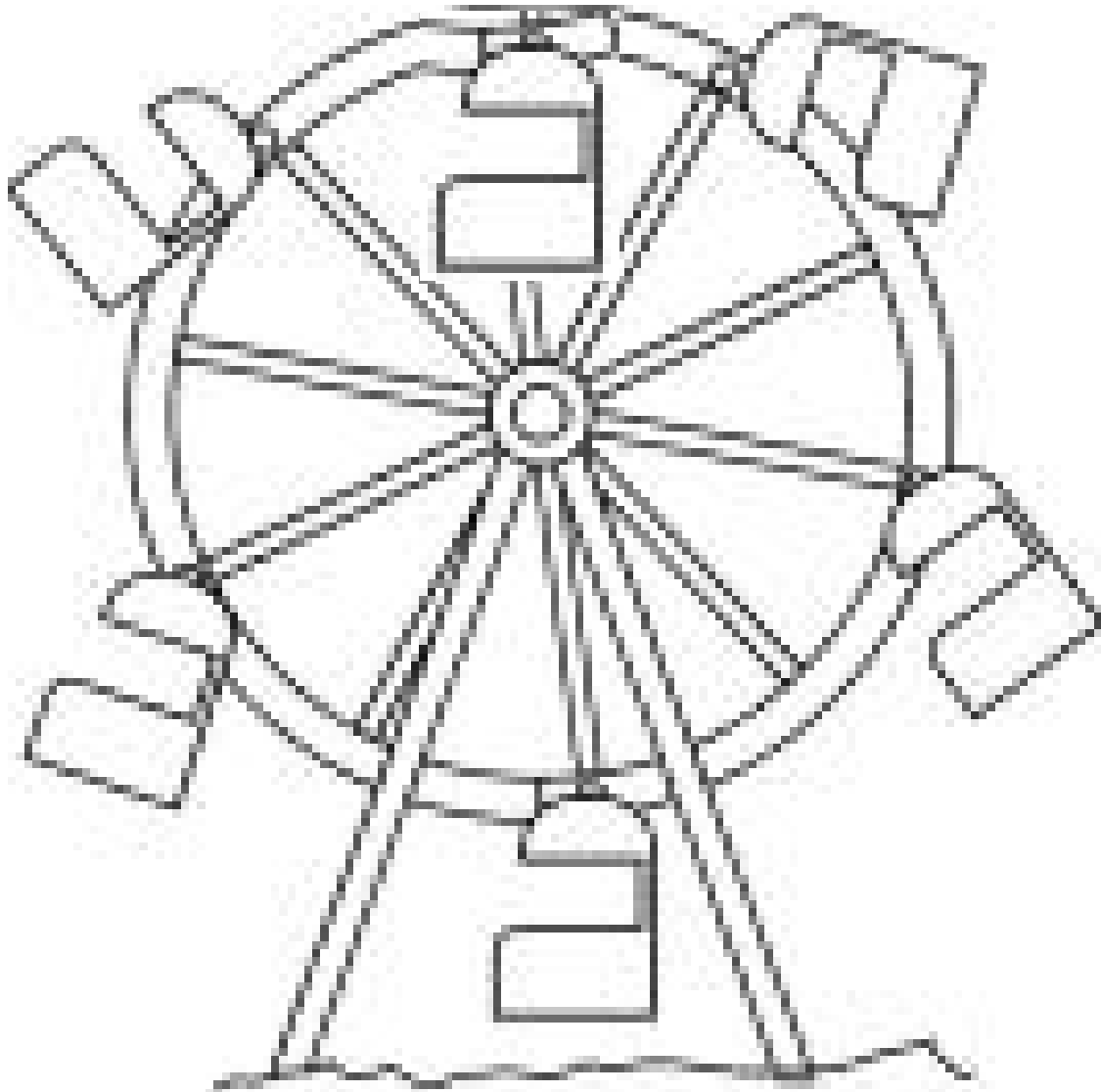
